## First-time buyer

chooses Fifth on the Park for its excellent location

FOR TORONTO NURSE Revellie Reyes, location topped her list of musthaves while she was shopping for her first home. The Scarborough renter decided a condominium suite at Fifth on the Park in Emerald City offered her an affordable option at a convenient address. Situated at Sheppard Avenue East and Don Mills Road, master-planned Emerald City is close to the Don Mills subway station and Fairview Mall. For Revellie, this is ideal. "I hate traveling through rush hour by car," she says. "From Fifth on the Park. I can take public transit. read a book or listen to music during my 10-minute commute. area, and barbecue terrace. "I can't
believe I'll have amenities right in my
building, plus this facility only steps
away. I love that an outdoor pool will
be added to the centre soon."

Fifth on the Park will rise to approximately 24 storeys from an approximately three-storey podium that will house retail venues on the

ground floor. "It's going to be convenient to have stores right there. And I'm looking forward to the WiFi Lounge in the lobby. What a great place to hang out and meet other people in the condominium. All of these amenities are great for my investment as well."

Numerous common areas will be shared with The Colours of Emerald City, such as an indoor pool, hot tub, his and hers change rooms and saunas, yoga room, fitness room, karaoke and theatre room (Revellie plans on using that a lot), arcade and games centre, lounge and dining room with fully-equipped kitchen, and an outdoor patio and dining area plus a barbecue terrace.

Revellie chose a one-bedroom plus den suite with a balcony. "I like that the den is located near the entry, and that the open-concept main living area makes the most of the space. It will be perfect for me and my partner. And from what I saw of the standard features and finishes in the presentation centre, I won't have to upgrade much or at all."
